

This Indenture, made this 16th day of February
 one thousand Eight hundred and fifty three between
 Wile Horton and Elizabeth Horton husband and
 Wife of the county of Shelby in the State of Alabama
 of the one part and Henry C. Horton of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Wile & Elizabeth Horton
 for and in consideration of the sum of fifty hundred
 — dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained and
 sold aliened, enfeoffed and conveyed and by these presents
 do bargain, sell enfeoff and convey to the said
 Henry C. Horton all that certain tract or parcel of
 land lying and being in the County of Shelby and
 State of Alabama and known and distinguished
 in the plan of survey of said State as the North
 West quarter — the West half of the North East quarter
 & the North West fourth of the South East fourth
 all in Section four Township 22 Range one East
 containing two hundred and eighty acres
 more or less.

To have and to hold the above described
 tract or parcel of land together with the
 tenements and appurtenances thereto belonging
 or in any wise appertaining unto the said Henry
 Horton his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said Wile & Elizabeth Horton for themselves
 their heirs Executors and administrators do warrant
 and well forever defend the title to the above descri-
 bed and hereby granted premises unto the said Henry
 C. Horton & his heirs and assigns from and against
 themselves and all and every person or persons claiming
 or holding under them the said Horton & Horton and
 also against the lawful title claim or demand of all
 and every person or persons whatsoever claiming or holding
 by fraud or under the government of the United
