 and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any  
 wise pertaining unto the said David G. McAssasson  
 his heirs and assigns forever And the said Joseph  
 & Mary D. Roper for themselves their heirs Executors &  
 administrators do warrant and will forever defend  
 the title to the above described and hereby granted  
 premises unto the said David G. McAssasson  
 heirs and assigns from and against Meiri  
 and all and every person or persons claiming or holding  
 under them the said Roper & wife and also against the  
 lawful title claim or demand of all and every person  
 or persons who successively claiming or holding by claim or  
 under the government of the United States
