 Shelby County } the third day of March AD
 1853 between, the firm of W L & D W Printer &
 Samuel Smith of the second part and French
 Nabors of the third part all of the State & County
 aforesaid Except the said Samuel Smith who
 is a Citizen of the City and County of Tuscaloosa
 in Witnesseth that Whereas the said David
 Andrews is indebted to the said D W Printer
 by a note for three hundred dollars bearing
 even date with this Present, and due the 1
 day of February AD 1854 and Whereas the
 said D W Printer is security for the said David
 Andrews on the following notes to wit a
 note for Eighty two & seventy five one hundred
 and thirty Dollars dated December 13 AD 1851 &
 payable Twelve months after date to the
 Order of Mary A Bandy and a note for
 Forty Seven Dollars and sixteen Cents due
 the first day of January AD 1853 payable
 to Edmund King and Whereas the said
 David Andrews is indebted to the firm
 of W L & D W Printer by note for one hun-
 dred & fifty dollars due on the first day
 of January AD 1854 And Whereas the
 said David Andrews is indebted to the said
 Samuel Smith by a note for one hundred
 & Twenty five & Eighteen one hundredths Dollars
 bearing date April the first AD 1852 and
 due one day after date Now the said David
 Andrews being desirous to secure the above
 mentioned debts to the said parties of the
 second part and also to make the said D
 W Printer safe from danger as his security
 on the above described notes This intention
 Witnesseth that the said David Andrews have
 bargained sold aliened and conveyed and by these
 presents do bargain sell alien and convey unto
 the said French Nabors for and in Consideration
 of the sum of five dollars of lawful money
 by the said French Nabors to the said David
 Andrews paid at and before the executing and
 delivery of these Presents. the receipt Whereof

is hereby acknowledged the following described
 personal property to wit one grey about nine
 years old One Bay Mare about two years old
 three Cows & Calves six head of Hogs one family
 Carriage One Sofa One Card table one side
 board six fine Chairs one Ward Robe one
 bureau one Leather bedstead two half do
 five feather beds and furniture and Medical
 and Miscellaneous library one set of Surgical
 instruments two large looking glasses all
 Kitchen and House hold furniture to have
 and to hold all the personal property hereby
 conveyed unto the said French Sabon his
 heirs & assigns unto the only proper use of
 the said French Sabon his heirs & assigns
 and the said David Andrews his heirs & assigns
 the aforesaid personal property hereby conveyed
 unto the said French Sabon his heirs & assigns
 against all persons whatsoever shall and
 will forever warrant and defend by these
 Presents upon trust however that the said
 French Sabon shall permit the said David
 Andrews to remain in quiet possession of the
 above described property hereby conveyed
 until the first day of February AD 1854
 if the debts in whole or in part to secure the
 payments of which they have made remain
 unpaid upon this further trust that he the said
 French Sabon his heirs & assigns shall and will
 as soon after the happening of said default
 of payment in whole or in part or he may
 think proper or the said Dr Printers the firm
 of W L & Dr Printers and Samuel Smith or
 each of them shall request sell the personal
 property hereby conveyed or such part as said
~~French Sabon~~ Trustee hereby authorized to act
 shall think sufficient for the purpose to the
 highest bidder for ready money at public
 auction after having fixed the time and
 place of sale and given twenty days notice
 by advertisement at Monroville and two
 other public places in the County aforesaid
 and out of the money arising from said sale

After satisfying the Charges thereof and all other
necessary Expenses shall pay and fully discharge
said debts and indemnify the said Dr Printer
against the debts due as aforesaid him to Mary
W Bandy & Edm King and shall pay said Dr
Printer the sum of \$100 & Dr Printer and
Samuel Smith and all Costs that shall have
accrued thereon & the residue of if any profits
to the said David Andrews But if the whole
of said debts be paid by the said David Andrews
so that no default be made in the payment
of the same either in whole or in part then
this undertaking to be void otherwise to remain
in full force and effect, Witness our hands
