 Trustee a deed of Trust to secure the payment
 of a Certain debt therein mentioned. and where
 as the said said Doak failed to make pay-
 ment of said debt on the 14 day of July
 1853. by Virtue of said deed of Trust
 After giving notice of the time & place
 of sale as was therein agreed I proceeded

to offer and sell to the highest bidder for cash at the Town of Monteville a Certain tract of land designated and pointed out in said deed of Trust as the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $N\frac{1}{2}$ also twenty acre off of the North End of the West side and the West half of the North West quarter of ~~8~~ & the $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of the $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section fourteen Township 24 Range 13 East Twp Kalbarra land distinct together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging to John M. McClanahan of said County of said he being the highest and best bidder for the sum of five hundred and seven dollars Now know ye that I John S. Storn as Trustee as aforesaid by virtue of the authority vested in me by the said Logan & Doak in said deed of Trust and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and ninety eight $88/100$ Dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell to said John M. McClanahan his heirs and assigns forever the above described tract of land and appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the said Logan & Doak had in the said tract of land on the said tenth day of January 1848. or at any time since had so far as the same is vested in me by said deed of Trust to have and to hold the said land and premises and every part thereof with the appurtenances therunto belonging to the said John M.
