 five and the East half of the North ~~West~~ quarter
 East quarter of Section six in Township twenty
 two of Range One East containing one hundred
 and sixty $3\frac{1}{4}$ acs or any to have and to hold the
 said tracts or parcels of land unto the said Henry
 I Gooden his heirs and assigns forever and we
 the said Rordon Bevell & Rutala his wife
 for ourselves one and each of us our and
 each of our heirs executors and administra-
 tors warrant and well ever defend the right
 and title to the said tracts of land unto the
 said Henry I Gooden his heirs and assigns

against the claims of all persons whatever
