

This Indenture made this the Twenty first
 day of May One thousand Eight
 hundred and fifty three between David
 G. Mason and Mary Mason husband &
 wife of the County of Shelby and in
 the State of Alabama of the one part
 and Joseph Roper and Gilbert McClanahan
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said
 party of the first part for and in
 consideration of the sum of one hundred
 25/100 dollars to them in hand paid then
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged how
 this day. Bargained granted sold. conveyed
 Expressed and conveyed and by these presents
 do bargain sell. convey and carry to
 Roper & McClanahan All that certain
 tract of parcel of land lying and being in

the town of Columbiana and State
of Hoboken & known & distinguished in
the Plan of Survey of said town as Lots
Eleven & twelve and also a small lot or
strip of land lying north of said lots up
to the center of the ditch and from the
corner of Broad Street to the street on
the west of the town all lying west of
the public square.

To have and to hold the above described
tract or lots of land together with the
tenements and appurtenances thereto belong-
ing or in any wise appertaining unto the
said Roper & McCluncheon their heirs and
assigns forever and the said party of the
first part for themselves their heirs Executors
& administrators do warrant & well forever
defend the title to the above described
and hereby granted premises unto the
said Roper and McCluncheon their heirs &
assigns from and against said first party
and all and every person or persons claiming
or holding under them the said first
party and all so against the lawful title
claim or demand of all and every person
or persons whatsoever claiming or holding
by from or under the government of the
United States & Testimony Whereof
