 day of June 1853 between Jesse P Green
 the debtor of the first part Joseph Roper
 and John M. McLanahan the creditors
 of the second part all of the county
 and state aforesaid witnesseth that where
 as the said Jesse P Green is indebted to
 the said Roper and McLanahan the
 sum of two hundred and seventy six
 21/100 dollars as a promissory note of this
 day will appear to be due the 18th day
 of January 1854 (next) which said debt
 the said Jesse P Green is anxious and
 desirous to secure therefore for and in
 consideration of the premises as well the
 sum of five dollars to him in hand
 paid the receipt whereof is hereby ack-
 nowledged the said Jesse P Green has
 given granted bargained and sold and
 by these presents does give grant bargain
 and sell to said Roper & McLanahan
 the following described land being and
 lying in said county and known as
 follows to wit the south east ^{4th} corner
 of section ten Township 24 Range 14
 East being the same land on which J. P.
 Green resides to have and to hold the
 same ^{wt} for ever upon trust nevertheless

untill default be made in the payment
be made afore said upon which default
said Roper and McLanahan either of them
there heirs and assigns may serve what adver
tice and sell said land to the highest
bidder for cash in columbiana having first
given 20 days notice of the time and place
of said sale by advertisement in at three
public places in said county and out of
said sale pay and satisfy the cost hereof
and said debt and the balance if any
pay over to said Green said Green is to
obtain the peaceable possession of said
land untill default is made in the
payment of the debt on said and should
if said debt be fully paid on its be com
ing due there this deed and conveyance to
be null and void of non effect witness
