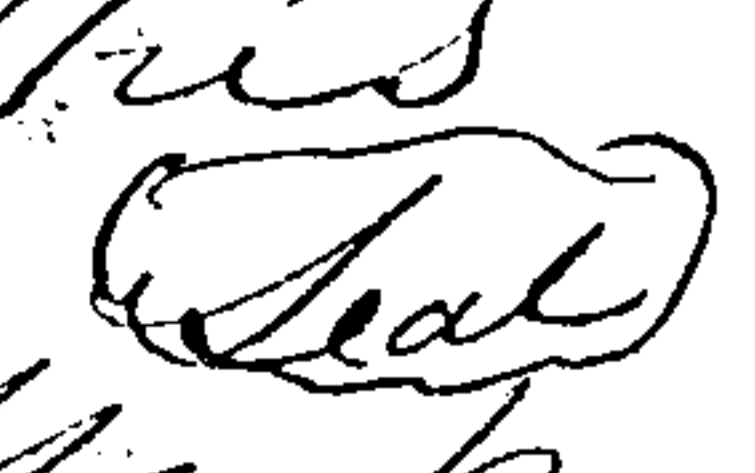


The of Alabama } Know all men by these
Shelby County } presents that on the 9th day
of June 1857 the court of Probate of said
County granted an order authorising the admin-
istrator of the Estate of Robert Bowdon late
of said County Dec to sell the real estate
of said Dec on a credit of Twelve months
taking note up with approved security &c
that in pursuance of said order I Thomas
H. Prasher the administrator of the estate

of said Dec did after giving an and legal notice
 of the time and place of said sale of said Estate of
 said dec on the 13 day of October 1857 at the late
 residence of said Dec in said county on the premi-
 ses, proceed to sell the same to wit. The W¹/₂ of
 the N. W¹/₄ of section 10 & all on the West side
 of Shoal Creek except what the mill pond
 covers & two acres at the mill of the East half of
 N. W¹/₄ Containing as supposed about forty
 acres and all on the West side of Shoal Creek except
 one rod from said Creek of the West half of the
 South West quarter containing about seventy
 nine acres more or less and all on the West side
 of Shoal Creek except one rod from said Creek of
 the E¹/₂ of S W¹/₄ containing about 20 acres all in
 section 10 & the E¹/₂ of the S E¹/₄ of section 9 & 30
 acres on the East side of the E¹/₂ of the N E¹/₄ of section
 9 all in Township 22 of Range 3 West, and also the
 West half of the S E¹/₄ of section 9. Township 22
 Range 3 West to the highest bidder on a credit of
 twelve months when Peter Deshazo, became the
 the highest bidder, therefore at the sum of twelve
 hundred & one Dollars that Peter Deshazo there-
 upon complied with the terms of said sale that
 said administrator afterwards & on the 18th day of
 October 1857 reported to said sale of said real estate
 of said Dec to the court of Probate of said County
 that said court thereupon confirmed the same
 and then ordered that administrator make title
 to said real estate to said Peter Deshazo. Now there-
 fore in consideration of the premises as well as in obedi-
 ence to the said order of said court. I Thomas W. Brasher
 as administrator as aforesaid do now by these presents
 sell convey and confirm unto the said Peter Deshazo
 all the right title interest claim and demand that
 the said Robert Bowdon Dec at the time of his death
 had of in & to the real estate above described To have
 and to hold the same to himself his heirs &
 assigns forever. In witness of all of which I
 Thomas W. Brasher administrator of said Robert
 Bowdon Dec here to set my hand & seal this
 the 23 day of May 1853
