 premises to the Warrum Butler his heirs Executors
 administrators and assigns to their use and behoof
 forever. And we do covenant with the said Warrum
 Butler his heirs Executors administrators and assigns
 that we are lawfully seized in fee of the afore granted
 premises that they are free of all incumbrances that
 we have good right to see and convey the same to
 said Warrum Butler and his heirs Executors admin-
 istrators and assigns and that we will warrant
 and defend the said premises to the said Warrum
 Butler his heirs Executors administrators and ad-
 signs forever against the Lawful claims & demands
 of all persons & testimony whereof we the said
