part Witnesseth that the said party of
 the first part for and in consideration
 of the sum of five hundred Dollars to them in
 William and paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 Armstrong have this day bargained granted sold aliened
 & wife enfeofed and conveyed and by these presents do
 bargain sell enfeof and convey to the said
 RRus Robert R. Rushing and to his heirs and assigns
 here all that certain tract or parcel of land lying
 and being and being in the County of Shelby
 and State of Alabama and known and dis-
 tinguished in the plan of survey of said
 State as the North West section of section
 No 20 Township 22 N Range one West and the
 North East fourth of the North West fourth of
 section No 20 Township 22 N Range 1 West
 To have and to hold the above described
 or parcel of land together with the tenements and
 appurtenances thereto pertaining or in any
 wise appertaining unto the said Rushing his
 heirs and assigns forever And the said Ar-
 mstrong & wife for them selves their heirs exec-
 utors and administrators do warrant and will
 forever defend the title to the above described &
 hereby granted premises unto the said RRus
 hing his heirs and assigns from and against
 us and all and every person or persons claiming
 or holding unto us the said 1st party and also
 against the lawful title claim or demand
 of all and every person or persons whose claim
 may or holding by from or under the govern-
 ment of the United States In testimony

 have hereunto set their hands and seals the day
 and year above written signed sealed and
