The state of Alabama; This Indenture made and entered
Shelby County into this the eighth day of August
one thousand eight hundred & fifty three between Robert
Bailey of the one part & Andrew Lee of the other
part both of the County & state aforesaid witnesses.
That whereas the said Lee hath this gone in a note
with the said R Bailey as his security said note pay-
able to Harrison Longory for the sum of sixty two
25 pro dollars due 25th Decr. 1854. Also a promissory
note the said Lee holds on the said R Bailey
for twenty dollars with interest and the said R Bailey
is willing & desirous to secure the said Lee by
giving him a lien on the following property (to wit)
One sound horse four Cows & yearlings shifer two
head of sheep and the said Bailey is to have
the use of said stock until the above described
notes are due & if he the said Bailey fails to pay
said note on or before the 25th of Decr. 1854. The
said Lee is as soon thereafter as he chooses
to expose the said property to public sale
giving a reasonable notice at such place as
he may think best. & if the said Bailey fails to
discharge the above notes and the said Lee
sells said property and the property being
over & above what will pay off said notes &
the cost of this trust the said Lee shall pay it
over to the said Bailey given under my
hand this 8th day of August AD 1853.
