Is Shelley County, entered into this 18th day of
April, A.D. 1857, between and fifty three between
James M. McGowan of the first part and
Benjamin Horrell of the second part.
Witnesseth that the party of the first part

for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dol-
lars to him in hand paid by Benjamin Arnett the second
party the receipt is hereby acknowledged has given
granted and conveyed and by these presents doth
give grant & convey unto the party of the second part
and to his heirs forever all the right title interest &
claim which the party of the first part holds claims
in & to the following described lands (viz) Island
"B" in Coosa River section 8 Township truly one
Range Two east & sold at Tuscaloosa containing
six $2\frac{7}{100}$ acres also Island A and the south half of
the same Coosa River Township truly one Range
Two east. sold at Tuscaloosa containing thirty four
acres To have & to hold the same forever against
the party of the first part & his heirs & all persons
holding or claiming under the said James
McGowan. In Testimony Whereof the party of the
first part hath this day signed sealed & delivered
this deed in the presence of & for the purposes herein
