conveyed and conveyed and by these presents
doth bargain sell convey and carry to
the said Baptist Church of Christ Burlah in
said County all that certain tract or parcel
of Land lying and being in the County
of Shelby and State of Alabama and known
and distinguished in the plan of survey
of said Land as the two acres in the
South West corner of the North East quarter
of the North West quarter of Section thirty
in Township Eighteen of Range Two
East being a square of two acres com-
mencing at said corner of said Tract which
said two acres is conveyed to said Church
to have and to hold the same to the
as said Church may exist and meet for
worship at the Church house now or here-
after erected on said land but should said
Church become dissolved said two acres of land
is by this deed to revert to & again become
the property in fee of said Henry Webster the
Church having the privilege of removing their
house of worship therefrom To have & to
hold the above described tract or piece
of land together with the tenements & appurtenances thereto belonging or in
any wise appertaining unto the said Burlah
Baptist Church so long as said Church
continues in existence & then meet for
worship & the said Henry Webster for himself
his executors & administrators doth warrant
& will forever defend the title to the above
described & hereby granted premises unto
the said Burlah Baptist Church

from and against himself call every person or persons claiming or holding under him the said Henry Webster sales against the lawful title claims or demands of all and every person or persons whosoever claiming or holding by from or under the government of the United States In Testimony whereof the said Henry Webster has hereunto set his hand & seal this day and year above written
