

The State of Alabama, This Indenture made the
 Shelby County 3rd 29th day of August 1853
 between William Dorris & Martha Dorris his
 wife of the County & state above mentioned of the
 first part & William F. McKee of Wilcox County
 state of Alabama of the second part. Witnesseth
 that the said William & Martha Dorris for
 & in consideration of one hundred dollars to us
 in hand paid by William F. McKee at or
 before the sealing & delivering of this Indenture
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 do hereby grant bargain sell enfeoff &
 confirm unto the said William F. McKee his
 heirs & assigns the following tract or parcel
 of land to wit. The undivided half of the
 south west quarter of the north East quarter
 of section five in Township Twenty Two of Range
 Third East Containing thirty nine acres
 & 4 hundredths the division line to run
 later cornered commencing at the north
 East corner & running to the south west
 corner the said land would extend one fourth
 of a mile from the south west corner east
 to a point at the north east corner the
 said lying & being in Shelby County subject
 to entry at Tuscaloosa Alabama to have
 & to hold the aforegranted premises to the
 said William F. McKee his heirs and

assigns to the use & behoof forever & we do Covenant
 unto the said William F. McKee his heirs &
 assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee of
 the aforesaid premises that they are free
 from all encumbrances that we have a
 good right to sell & convey the same to the
 said William McKee his heirs & assigns
 & that we will warrant & defend the premi-
 ses to the said William F. McKee his heirs
 & assigns forever against the lawful claims
 & demands of all persons in right whereof
 we the said William & Martha Donip have
 hereto set our hands & affixed our seals
 this 29 day of August 1853.
