 of September 1853 between Willis A. Morgan
 the debtor of the first part & David McLean
 administrator of the second part all of the County
 estate aforesaid witnesseth that whereas the
 said W. A. Morgan is justly indebted to Martin
 H. McHenry in the sum of one hundred & twenty
 three dollars more or less due by a judgment
 in the Circuit Court of said County and
 to Elizabeth Reeves the sum of twenty
 four dollars including costs more or less

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The property conveyed in this deed of trust sold and the proceeds therefrom
applied to the payment of the debts herein enumerated which entitled
them in full up Eighty four 00/100 dollars which has been settled with

dollars due by promissory note dated
6 April 1852 & due one day after date
with interest from 1 January 1852 & to
said D. McCallahan the further sum of
thirty nine 9/100 dollars by note dated 30
August 1853 & due one day after date
with interest from 1 January 1853 & to said
D. McCallahan the further sum of sixty
seven 7/100 dollars due by promissory note
dated this 21 day of September 1853 & due
one day after date also to D. McCallahan
& in the further sum of thirty five 5/100
dollars due by promissory note of even
date herewith & due one day after
date & to John T. L. Conner the sum of
twenty six 6/100 dollars due by note
dated 5 of March 1853 & due one day after
date & to John P. West the sum of thirty
five dollars more or less due on the
Magistrates docket & to D. W. Caldwell
& the further sum of forty eight dollars
more or less due by judgment on a magis-
trates docket & also to J. S. Brasher the
sum of forty five dollars or thereabouts
due by judgment on Magistrates docket
to R. W. Brasher fifteen dollars more
or less due by Magistrates judgment & to

 of section 14 Township 21 Range 2 West & eight
 head of cattle & stock of hogs thirty in the
 more or less the same now in my possession
 also my growing crop of corn fodder cotton
 & potatoes of every description & kind to
 have & to hold the same forever upon trust
 nevertheless the said McClanahan is to
 gather said crop & sell the whole of the
 same the cattle & hogs at private sale
 for fair prices & the balances of said
 property real & personal to the highest
 bidder for cash giving twenty days notice
 of said sale of the time & place to be
 selected by him out of the proceeds of
 said sale pay & satisfy said debts. the
 said debts to said McHenry & first debt
 to said Roper & the debt to Mrs E Reaves
 in full & the balances pro Rata the said
 McClanahan first paying the expenses
 hereof & a reasonable compensation for
 his trouble & after all is paid the balances
 of the sale of said property said McClanahan
 is to pay over to Mrs Lydia Morgan
