To have & to hold the said tracts or parcels of land & premises unto the said Elisha C. Wilson & to his heirs & assigns forever And we the said Argulas & Rachael his wife for ourselves our heirs executors & administrators Covenant & agree to & with the said Elisha C. Wilson his heirs & that the said Argulas Henderson is lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted tracts or parcels of land that they and free from all incumbrances & that we have good right to sell and Convey the same to the said Elisha C. Wilson & that we will by these presents defend the right title to said tracts or parcels of land unto the premises & appurtenances unto the said Elisha C. Wilson & to his heirs & assigns forever against all persons whomsoever In witness of which we hereunto set our hands & affix our seals this 2nd day of January AD 1844.
