of Shelby on Monday the fifth day of February AD 1844
proceed at public outcry to sell the same when Elisha
C. Wilson was the highest & best bidder therefor at
the price of seven $4/100$ dollars the same being
knocked off to him the said Elisha C. Wilson
for the sum aforesaid. In consideration of which
I Thomas H. Brasher Sheriff as aforesaid do hereby
bargain sell and convey unto him the said Elisha
C. Wilson his heirs & assigns the following described
property to wit the following Real Estate that is
to say the North East half of the south west
fourth of section thirty six Township nineteen
Range one west in the Tuscaloosa land
district To have & to hold said bargain
ed property or premises unto him the said
Elisha C. Wilson his heirs & assigns forever
And I the said Thomas H. Brasher Sheriff
as aforesaid do so far as the office of Sheriff
authorizes me hereby warrant said property or
real estate unto him the said Elisha C. Wilson
his heirs & assigns & the same to have & hold
use & enjoy in the same manner the aforesaid
Jeremiah W. Ginn defendant as aforesaid
could or might have held & enjoyed
said property had not the same been
seized & sold by virtue of the writ aforesaid
