 To Shelby County } entered into the 22^d day
 of October 1853 between Rassy Wallace of
 the first part & Charles B. Elliott of the
 second part Witnesseth that the said Rassy
 Wallace of the first part is justly indebted
 to the said Charles B. Elliott of the second
 part in the sum of Eighty dollars
 which said debt said Rassy Wallace
 is anxious & desirous to accept and

Whereas the Condition of said debt is for goods
 furnished by said Charles B. Elliott to said
 Rasey Wallace therefore the said Rasey Wallace
 is anxious & desirous to secure the payment of
 said debt therefore for and consideration of the
 following property as well as the sum of
 One dollar to him in hand paid by the
 said Charles B. Elliott the Receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged said Wallace has
 given granted bargained & sold & by these
 presents does give grant bargain & sell to the
 said Charles B. Elliott the following property
 (viz) Two feather beds & furniture & truss head
 of hogs two Corns & calves one Two years old Colt
 of black color & one yearling Colt of bay color
 now in my possession to have & to hold the
 same forever upon trust nevertheless it is hereby
 expressly agreed & understood that said Wallace is
 to retain the possession of the said property
 untill said Elliott or his representatives may
 think proper to release the same then said
 Elliott upon default of the payment of said
 debt for Eighty dollars may seize take & sell
 said property to the highest bidder for cash
 first giving ten days notice of the time and
 place of said sale in at least three public
 places in said County & out of the proceeds of
 said sale pay said debt & cost thereof & the
 balance if any pay over to said Wallace
 but should the same be fully paid then
 this deed of trust to be void & of no force
 otherwise to remain in full force & effect
