 section twenty Township twenty of range two east
 also the Northwest quarter (1/4) of the Northwest quarter
 (1/4) of section twenty Township twenty range two
 east in the Tuscaloosa land district containing eighty
 acres. containing eighty acres, be the same more or
 less. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract of
 parcel of land, together with all and singular
 the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto

belonging or in anywise appertaining unto
 the sale and proper use of behoof & benefit
 of the party of the second part and his heirs
 And assigns in fee Simple and the party of
 the first part for themselves and their
 heirs Executors and administrators do
 hereby Covenant and agree to and with
 the party of the second part & his heirs
 And assigns in manner and form following
 to wit That he is seized of an indisputable
 Estate in fee free from all incumbrances
 done or suffered from the party of the
 first part and from any other persons
 or persons And also for quiet enjoyment
 against the party of the first part
 their heirs and all persons whatsoever
 in and to the premises aforesaid. In
