Containing forty acres more or less in the land & district subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama. Together with all and singular the appertinances hereditaments and rights in anywise appertaining unto the said Charnal W Schoggin his heirs and assigns forever and the said Greenberry & Sarah W. Seale for themselves their heirs Executors & Administrators with warrant and will ever defend the Right and title to the above described & hereby conveyed premises unto the said C W. Schoggin his heirs & assigns and from against the claim of them the said Greenberry & Sarah W. Seale ^{and} every person or persons claiming or holding under or by the said Greenberry & Sarah W. Seale and also against the lawful title claim or demand of all and every person or persons claiming or holding under the general government of the United States of America.
