 James M. Johnson all that tract or parcel of
 land lying and being in the County of Shelby and
 state aforesaid. And known as the West half of
 the South East quarter of section 1 in Township

It Range 3 West containing Eighty acres more or less in the District of Land subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama together with all and singular appertinances heradilaments and rites in any wise appertaining under the said James M. Johnson his heirs and assigns forever and the said Blasengame Nabors for himself his heirs Executors and administrators doth warrant and will forever defend the title and title to the said described lands and hereby conveyed premises unto the said James M. Johnson his heirs and assigns from and against the claims of him the said Blasengame Nabors and all and every person or persons claiming or holding under or by the said Blasengame Nabors and also against the lawful title claim or demand of all and every person or persons whomever claiming or holding by or from under the General Government of the United States in testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year above written.
