This indenture, made this Thirteenth day of December one thousand eight hundred and fifty three between Meile J Horton Jr of the County of Shelby in the state of Alabama of the one part, and Isaac W Edwards of the other part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained, sold, Granted sold, aliened, enfeoffed and conveyed, and by these presents doth bargain, sell, enfeoff and convey to the said Isaac W Edwards, All of that ~~tract~~ certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Shelby and state of Alabama and known and distinguished in the plan of survey of said state as the South end of the North-West fourth of section No. Twenty Four. Township Twenty One of Range One East. Containing Seventy Two acres and a half more or less. Nevertheless the line layed between Thomas Horton and said Meile J. Horton Jr. is to be the boundary line.

So have and to hold, the above described tract of land together with the tenements and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said Isaac W. Edwards his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Meile J Horton his heirs Executors and administrators, doth warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described land hereby Granted premises unto the said Isaac W. Edwards his heirs and assigns from and against themselves and all and every person or persons, whosoever claiming or holding by, from or under the government of the United States.
