

Brasher admr. of Gilbert
 To
 Whilfield Court of said County, ordered & decreed a sale of
 the real estate of William Gilbert late of said
 County deceased. That said order & decree were
 made on having proof on the trial of the petition
 of Thos. H. Brasher as the administrator of the
 Estate of said Deceased which has been permi-

Now therefore in consideration of the premises as well as in obedience to the order of said court I Thomas H. Brasher as administrator as aforesaid do now by these presents, bargain, sell, convey & confirm unto the said Abraham H. Whitfield all the right, title, interest, claim, & demand that the said William Gilbert deceased at the time of his death had of in & to the said tract or parcel of land above designated, to have and to hold the same to himself his heirs & assigns forever, In witness of which I the said Thomas H. Brasher as administrator of the estate of the said William Gilbert dec^d. hereunto set my hand & seal this the 25 day of October A.D. 1853
