 one thousand eight hundred and fifty

 part, and William Rye and Ann B. Rye of
 the other part. Witnesseth: That the said William
 Rye and Ann B. Rye for and in consideration
 of the sum of six hundred dollars to us
 in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, hath this day bargained, gran-
 ted sold, aliened enfeoffed and conveyed, and
 by these presents do bargain, sell, enfeoff and
 convey to the said Nathan Prime. All that
 certain tract or parcel of land lying and be-
 ing in the county of Shelby and state of
 Alabama and known and distinguished by
 in the plan of survey of said lands as the
 NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No 4 in Town-
 ship 20. And Range 2. East in the district of
 Tuscaloosa also the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section
 No 5. And the + SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section No. 4
 both in Township Twenty (20). and Range
 2 East also the S W $\frac{1}{4}$ of S W $\frac{1}{4}$ of section No
 34. Township Nineteen (19) Range Two (2) East
 also the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section Three (3)
 Township Twenty (20) Range Two east in
 district of Tuscaloosa, also the S W $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE
 $\frac{1}{4}$ of section Three (3) Township Twenty (20) &
 Range Two (2) East in the district of Tuscaloosa
 To have and to hold, the above described tract
 or parcel of lands together with the tenements
 and appertinances thereto belonging or in any
 wise appertaining unto the said Nathan Prime
 his heirs and assigns forever. And the said
 William Rye and Ann B. Rye their heirs
 Executors and administrators do warrant
 and will forever defend the title to the above
 described and hereby granted premises unto
 the said Nathan Prime his heirs and assigns
 from and against the legal claims of all
 and every person or persons claiming or holding
 under them the said William Rye and also
 against the lawful title, claim or demands

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of all and every person or persons whosoever claim-
ing or holding by, from or under the government
of the United States hath hereunto set their hands
and seals the day and year above written.
