W Bevil This indenture made and entered into this
12 day of November AD 1835 between Myatt Bevil
Wallace and Mary A Bevil husband and wife of the
one part and Robert B Wallace of the other part
all of the county of Shelby state of Alabama. Wit-
nesseth that the said Myatt Bevil and Margaret
Bevil husband and wife for and in consideration
of the sum of one hundred and ten dollars to
them in hand paid by the said Robert Wallace
the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged have
this day bargained sold and conveyed and by
these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the
said Robert B Wallace all that certain tract
or parcel of land lying and being in the county
of Shelby & state of Alabama and known and
described as S E 1/4 of the N E 1/4 of Section 7 in Town-
ship 20, and in range 2 East in the district of
land subject to sale at Tuscaloosa. To have
and to hold with all and singular the ten-
ements and appertinances thereto belonging
unto the said Robert B Wallace his heirs and
assigns forever. And said Myatt Bevil and
Mary A Bevil husband & wife do hereby
warrant and will forever defend the title
to the above described lands unto the said
Robert B. Wallace his heirs and assigns for-
ever against all lawful claim of all and
every person in law and equity. Given un-
