 Shelby and State of Alabama of the first part  
 and Jefferson Norris of the second part of  
 the same County and State Witnesseth that  
 the said party of the first part hath  
 bargained sold and delivered and do by these  
 Presents bargain sell and convey unto Jeff-  
 =erson Norris the party of the second part  
 all their title and interest to the S E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
 N  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 15. T20 R3W. Except three acres

more or less on the East side of a branch  
running South joining lands of Malden  
Bay also W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the same section  
of Range and the said party of the first  
part in and for the Consideration of the  
sum of forty four dollars & 44 Cents to  
them in hand paid the receipt whereof is  
humbly acknowledged do for themselves  
their heirs Executors and administrators  
and assigns forever quit Claim all  
right and title of or to said land unto  
the said Jefferson Morris here and his heirs  
and assigns forever in testimony whereof  
they have hereunto set their hands and  
Seals this day and year first above written
