 hundred dollars to him in hand payed
 by the said E. Koolsonback the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargain
 sold & conveyed & do hereby bargain sell &
 convey unto the said E. Koolsonback
 his heirs, executors, administrators, & assign-
 es, all that or parcel of land lying &
 being in Shelby County & state of Alabama
 subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Court and
 described as follows, to wit: all that part
 of the west half of south east fourth of
 section three in Township twenty two of
 range three west that lies north of Shoal
 Creek; also all that part of the East half
 of South west fourth of the same section,
 Township & range that lies north of the afore-
 said Creek; also all that part of the west half
 of the South West fourth of the same section
 Township & range that lies East of an other
 branch of the same creek, & adjoining the land of Ler-
 miah Lolly, supposed to contain about one
 hundred & twenty acres more or less, to
 have and to hold the same with all & sin-
 gular the right, title & interest in said
 above described land to have & to hold
 the aforesaid premises unto the said
 E. Koolsonback, his heirs, executors,

and administrators and assignees in fee simple
and I the said ~~Gilley~~ John S Gilley my heirs,
executors, administrators & assignees will warrant
& defend forever the aforesaid bargained premises against
the claim or claims of any & every and every
