 Co. Morrow Shelby County. } presents That I Jesse Coshatt
 for & in consideration of being indebted to Thom-
 as L. Morrow - by a promissory note dated September
 7th 1854 & due one day after ~~date~~ the date thereof
 for eighty four dollars & six cents - said note signed
 by the said Coshatt & payable to the said Morrow
 bearer & the better to secure the same - have
 this day bargained sold & conveyed & by these pres-
 ents do bargain sell & convey - unto the said
 Thomas L. Morrow his heirs &c - all the crop of
 corn & cotton now growing on the Land - cul-
 tivated & dwelt upon by the said Coshatt. The same
 lying & being in the county & state aforesaid, to have
 & to hold the above granted crop to the said Thomas L.
 Morrow, his heirs &c, upon the condition nevertheless
 that in case the said Jesse Coshatt shall pay the
 note above described by the 1st day of November 1854,
 with the interest that may accrue thereon, then
 this deed to be void; But if default be made in
 the payment of said note on the 1st day of November
 1854, it shall be lawful for the said Thomas L.
 Morrow to take possession of the crop above granted
 & sell the same to the highest bidder at public
 auction for cash at Montevallo in the county
 & state aforesaid, giving ten days of said sale by
 posting an advertisement in the said town of Mon-
 tevallo, paying back the balance if any to, after
 deducting the amount of said note with the expen-
