the 26th day of November A. D. 1850 between
Joseph Roper and Mary Roper his wife of the
first part and David H. McClanahan of the sec-
ond part all of the county and state aforesaid,
Witnesseth that the party of the first part for and
in consideration of the sum of nine hun-
dred dollars to them in hand paid by the said
David H. McClanahan the receipt of which is
herely acknowledged the said party of the first
part have given granted bargained and sold and
by these presents do give grant bargain and sell
to said party of the second part and his heirs
forever the following described land lying and
being situate in the Town of Columbiana
known as follows; to wit: The lot on which
the said D. H. McClanahan now lives upon
and uses for a Tavern and being the lot and
house formerly occupied and used by James
O'Hara for a Tavern lot being the same
which lies between the North and South
Street and the Section line and between the
main Tuscaloosa road and the lot occupied
the present year by J. B. Allen except the lot
owned by H. W. Nabors and the lot on which
is situate the shop used by Samuel Wallace
as a Blacksmith shop, To have and to hold the
same forever, and we the party of the first
part do covenant with the party of the second
part that we will forever warrant defend titles
in fee simple to him and his heirs forever
to said lot of land. Witness our hands and
seals this day and year aforesaid.
