

Brasher and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to us in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents bargain sell convey and confirm unto Allen Rusting and Sawyer in the following designated and described lot or parcel of land situate in the Town of Colera bicana in said County on which the ston house of the said Brashers is situated commencing at the south east corner of said ston house on the public square in said town and public street from the Court house running North thence west along the public square to the corner where it intersects with the lot now owned & occupied by Wm A. Allen thence North to the lot now owned by B. Y. Dumas, thence east to the North west corner of J. M. Melanahans office lot now occupied by Dr Jones thence south to the south west corner of said Melanahans lot; thence east to the south east corner of the said Melanahans lot; thence east to the south east corner of said Melanahans lot on the said public street running from the Court house North, thence to the beginning together with all and any other the premises & appurtenances belonging to A. A. Smith his law office and shoping under those with the privilege of occupying or moving at his pleasure, to have and to hold the same to the said Allen Rusting and Sawyer their heirs and assigns forever And in the said Samuel Brasher and Thomas H. Brasher do now by these presents warrant and will ever defend the right and title to said lot of land & premises & appurtenances above described unto said Allen Rusting & Sawyer his heirs and assigns against all persons whatever as witness our hands and seals this the 5th day of April 1856
