This Indenture made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of March in the

and State of Alabama of the one part and Joseph W.

other part witnesseth that the said Edward Lee  
for and in Consideration of the sum of three hundred  
dollars to him in hand paid by the said Isaac  
W. Johnson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
that the said Edward Lee has this day given  
granted bargained sold alined conveyed and  
confirmed and by these presents doth give grant  
bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto  
the said Isaac W. Johnson his heirs &c from a  
certain tract of land in the County of Shelby and  
State aforesaid lying in the district of Cane's Hole  
at Tuscaloosa being to wit, N. of the N. W. 1/4 of the North  
East quarter of section No. 13 Township 13 Range 2  
west also South east 1/4 of the South West 1/4 of said section  
(Township) & range also South west 1/4 of the N. E. 1/4 of  
said section 13 T. 13 R. 2. west containing one  
hundred and twenty acres less or more to have  
and to hold the before mentioned land and bargained  
pursess with all and singular the rights profits  
immedietants and appurtenants of in to the same  
belonging or in anywise appertaining to the only  
proper use benefit and behoof of the said Isaac W.  
Johnson his heirs and assigns from and the  
said Edward Lee for himself his heirs &c  
doth further covenant and agree to and with  
the said Isaac W. Johnson his heirs &c that he  
before mentioned land and bargained pursess he  
will warrant and forever defend against the right  
title interest or claim of all and every person or persons  
whatsoever in witness whereof the said Edward Lee  
has hereunto set his hand and affixed his  
seal the day and year first above written
