 Shelby County. } the sixth day of August, one thousand
 eight hundred and fifty-six, between N. Lee and his wife
 Nancy, of the first part, and Thos. Griffin, of the second part,
 witnesseth: That the said party of the first part hath this day
 bargained and sold, and do by these presents grant, bargain
 and sell unto the said party of the second part a certain
 tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of
 Shelby and State of Alabama, and in the Tuscaloosa Land
 District, and known as follows, to wit- the East half of the
 North-East quarter Section twenty-two; also the West half of
 the North-West quarter Section twenty-three, Township twenty
 Range three West; for the consideration of the sum of two
 Hundred Dollars in hand paid by the party of the second
 part unto the party of the first part, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged. And the said party of the first
 part doth of themselves, their heirs, executors, adminis-
 trators and assigns, well warrant and for ever defend
 all the right, title and interest of said land unto the said party
 of the second part, his heirs &c. together with all that ap-
 pertaineth unto said land. In testimony whereof, we have
 hereunto set our names and affixed our seals day and
 year first above written.
