The State of Alabama, this Indenture, made and entered  
Shelby County. unto this the nineteenth day of Novem-  
ber, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six between N.  
Lee and his wife Nancy of the first part, and Alfred Griffin  
of the second part, witnesseth: that the said party of the first

part hath this day bargained and sold, and do by these presents grant, bargain and sell unto the party of the second part a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county and State aforesaid and in the Tuscaloosa Land District, to wit: the W. $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N.W. gr.; also a fraction off of the North end of W. $\frac{1}{2}$  of S.W. gr. containing thirty acres divided by a cross fence running between S. F. Wilson & said Lee; also a fraction off the East half of the South-West quarter, it being off the North end of said half, bounded by the creek running through said land, containing twenty-five acres, more or less; also the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ ; all in Section thirty-two Township nineteen Range two West containing forty acres; also a part of the South-East gr. of the N.E. gr. ~~of~~ Sec. 31 T. 19 R. 2 W. commencing East corner running to the N.W. corner, containing twenty acres; for the consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars to the party of the first part in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. And the said party of the first part doth for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, with warrant and forever defend all the right, title and interest of said land unto the party of the second part, his heirs &c.; together with all that in any wise appertaineth unto said land.
