 To Present that Whereas I Reason Wallaw Am indebted to Mr
 Elliott Elliott in the sum of five hundred and Twenty Eight & 00/100
 Dollars for the payment of which I have Executed my promissory
 note bearing date of May 3^d 1857 and due the 25 day of
 December next for the sum above mentioned and one
 dollar in hand paid here therefore in consideration of
 securing the payment of said sum of money and
 one dollar in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged and of other good and valuable con-
 siderations I the said Reason Wallaw have bargained
 and sold and confirmed unto the said Mr Elliott
 the following property One Grey Horse and Cow &
 Calf and all of my present growing crop of Corn
 and Cotton on the plantation of farm in Fulton
 To have and to hold the above described property
 and effects to him and to his heirs forever the Condi-
 tion of this conveyance such that if the said Reason
 Wallaw shall well and truly pay to the said
 Mr Elliott the sum of five hundred and twenty
 Eight & 00/100 Dollars with all interest cost & charges,

according to the tenor and Effect of said note this
 Campaign to be void Else to remain in full force
 and the said J M Elliott shall at all times have
 power to take into possession and sell at public
 sale by after giving two days notice the property
 herein mentioned for the purpose aforesaid
 given under my hand and seal this 23 day 1857
