

McCaughey This indenture made and entered into the 17 June A.D.
 To One thousand Eight hundred and fifty seven between
 Sted. William McCaughey of the County of Shelby of the
 first part and Sylvester Sted Trustee of the County
 of Jefferson of the second part and Alfred H. Ralback
 and Abner Kellogg of the County of Jefferson and
 all of the State of Alabama Witnesses Whereby the
 said party of the first part is indebted to Samuel
 & Esch Guardian of Thomas A. Kelly of the County
 of Jefferson One thousand dollars due by note dated
 June the 6 1856 And due one day after date with
 interest from the 10 April 1856 and the said
 Alfred H. Ralback and Abner Kellogg are my
 securities for the payment of the money to the said
 Samuel & Esch Guardian & and being William &
 Descreaux to serve the said party of the third part
 my securities both bargain sold and conveyed
 And both by their presents grant bargain sell and
 convey unto Sylvester Sted Trustee and in trust
 the following described property lying and situate
 in the town of Montevallo in the North East quar-
 -ter of lot No 40 as which is situated the store house
 formerly occupied by me but since and now
 by lot of James George as a graving store and lot
 being thirty six feet front and running back
 said lot also the undivided three fourths of
 lot No 41 as which is situated the Shelby Hotel
 and now occupied by me together with the other
 tenements and appurtenances belonging to said
 lots to be held by Sylvester Sted for the following purposes

If the said William McCaughy shall pay or
 Cause to be paid said above described debt of
 One thousand Dollars interest Costs & Expenses
 of this deed when required so to do by said third
 party Alfred H. Raeburn and Abner Kellough
 this deed in trust to be void and of no effect but
 should the said McCaughy fail to pay as
 aforesaid the Trustee Sylvester Steele is authorized
 to advertise and sell said above described
 property giving first thirty days notice before
 sale at three public places in the County and
 sell said property to the highest bidder for Cash
 in the town of Monticello and apply the pro-
 ceeds of said sale to the payment of said described
 debt Costs &c but the property is only to be sold
 by the trustee after he is required by the party
 Raeburn and Kellough and after described
 property is sold and money applied if any money
 remains in the hands of said Trustee he is to
 return the same to William McCaughy In
 testimony the aforesaid parties here set their
 hands and affixed their seals this day and
 year above written William McCaughy Trust
Sylvester Steele Trust
