The State of Alabama } This indenture made the 22nd day of
Shelby County } June 1857 between William B.
Huddleston of Shelby County Ala of the first part and
John S. Storrs of said county of the second part and
John P. West of said county of the third part. Witnesseth
That the said party of the first part is justly indebted
to the said John S. Storrs in the sum of One hundred &

nine ^{12/24} 100 dollars, due by promisor ^{note} on the first day of Jan-
 -uary 1858 which he is anxious to secure to the said party
 of the second part. Now in consideration of the premises and
 and for the further consideration of one dollar to him
 in hand paid by the party of the third part the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged hereby grants bargains and
 sells unto the said party of the third part two yoke of oxen
 (one red steer and one priced steer Buck one pale red steer
 Benz & a branded priced steer Charley, also one four ox wagon
 & bed, To have and to hold unto the said party of the
 third part his heirs and assigns forever. In Trust However
 that the said party of the first part have possession of said
 oxen & wagon till default be made in payment of said
 debt by said party of the first part. But if default be
 made in payment of said debt then said party of
 the third part shall be authorized to seize and sell said
 oxen & wagon at public sale giving ten days notice by
 advertisement at Maentwalle and appropriate the
 proceeds of said sale first to the payment of the said debt
 and interest and then the costs of this Trust and the
 remainder if any pay to the said party of the first
