A.D. 1887 Between N. J. Norris of the first part and  
Edmund King of the second part all of Shelby County  
Alabama Witnesseth that for and in Consideration  
of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to me in hand  
paid by the said Edmund King the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged I have bargained & sold  
and by these Presents doth bargain sell & convey  
unto the said Edm King the undivided  
half of the following tract of land designated  
as the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 21 also the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the  
NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 28 also the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 29 also the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 29 all  
in Township 24 of Range 12 E lying and  
being in Bibb County Alabama and Jackson  
in land district or which tract of Land

there is a grant and saw well on Alabama Creek  
 together with all & singular the appurtenances thereto  
 to be laying or in any way appertaining to have  
 and to hold unto the said Edmund King Lewis  
 Lewis and assigns forever And the said J. Morris  
 for himself his heirs Executors and administrators  
 do Warrant and forever defend the title of the  
 said half interest of said tract of land unto  
 him the said Edmund King against the claim  
 and demand of all persons whatsoever in  
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
 And affixed my seal in Common form on the  
 day and year above written the South half  
 of the NE 1/4 Sec 29 Entered before signed
