On the 12 day of November A.D. 1855 after due and legal notice as aforesaid upon the premises at Public Court my proceed to sell to the highest and best bidder the land, belonging to the Estate of said John Punter of the Township and being in said County of Shelby viz the West and W. 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of Section 9 and all that part of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and the E 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 5 which lies of the Western bank of Shual Creek and also the E 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 8 also the E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 5. also the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 4 all lying in Township 24 Range 12 E. the whole containing two hundred and twenty two and a half Acres and where as William P Brown being the highest & best bidder for said land became the purchaser of said land at the sum of two thousand One hundred and ninety four 11/100 dollars at said Sale which sale was duly reported to said Probate Court and by the same approved and where said Brown has made full payment to me of said purchase money and the receipt whereof and by me in full & truly acknowledged and where said sale has been reported to said Probate Court whereupon said Court decreed and directed title to said land to be made to said Brown now thereupon for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and the said sum of money to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged I have given granted conveyed and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell all and every of said land W P Brown and to his heirs and assigns the land aforesaid described together with all the rights & privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging & appertaining given under my hand and seal this 13 day of March 1857
