

Nelson & Co. This Indenture made and entered into this 9th day
 To of July 1855 between Henderson W. Nelson as Sheriff of
 Shelby County in the State of Alabama of the one part
 Earle & Wright of Earle & Wright of the County of Jefferson & said
 State of the other part Witnesseth that whereas on
 the first day of March 1855 Judgment was duly rendered
 in the Circuit for the County of Jefferson in the State
 aforesaid at the Spring Term of the said Circuit
 Court for the sum Two Hundred Two 00/100 Dollars
 besides cost in favor of the said Earle & Wright
 and against Jacob H. Baker on which said Judgment
 there was issue by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for
 said County on the 6th day of March 1855 a
 certain writ of Fieri Facias in favor of the said
 Earle & Wright and against the said Jacob H.
 Baker directed to any Sheriff of the State of Alabama
 Whom said Sheriff was directed to levy of the Estate of
 said Jacob H. Baker the sum of two hundred and
 two 00/100 dollars besides sum 30/100 dollars Costs &
 which said writ was on the 20 day of March 1855
 placed in the hands of said H. W. Nelson as Sheriff
 of said County of Shelby with for the purpose of its
 levy and Execution and whereas said Henderson
 W. Nelson as Sheriff as aforesaid after the said writ had
 come into his hands and while the same was
 in full force did on the first day of June
 1855 levy the same on the following tract
 of land as the property of the said Jacob
 H. Baker viz the SW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ the NE¹/₄
 of the SW¹/₄ of Section 19 T 18 R 2 N.
 Also the E¹/₂ of the SE¹/₄ and the SW¹/₄
 of the SE¹/₄ of Section 24 T 18 R 2 N.
 Lying and being in the County of Shelby
 and whereas the said H. W. Nelson as Sheriff
 as aforesaid after having duly advertised
 the said land for sale he then made
