 consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars
 to us in hand paid the party of the second part the
 receipt of which A. M. Lester acknowledges, do hereby give
 grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Francis
 Davis and his heirs forever the following described
 land lying and being in said County and in Tuscaloosa
 land district to wit the S. W. 1/4 of S. W. 1/4 of Sec 13 and N. W. 1/4
 of N. W. 1/4 of section 24 Township 20 of range 2 west
 containing six acres and more or less
 and a half hundredths, to have and to hold said
 land and premises with the appurtenances thereto
 belonging unto him the Francis Davis his
 heirs and assigns forever. I the said party of the
 first part do covenant do and with said party
 of the second part that I am lawfully seized
 of the premises aforesaid and that I will form
 warrant and defend title in full sample to
 the premises aforesaid, Witness my hand and
