Stewart his heirs and assigns for ever together with all the title privileges appertinances there unto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the first parties is to have the title of Cultivating and the use of the cleared Land on said Land about eight-
 teen acres during of each of their lives and the first parties for themselves their heirs and assigns Executors Administrators and assigns do and by these presents will will for every warrent and defend the title from themselves their heirs and from all and from every person or person what so ever in testimony whereof the first parties here unto set their hands and seals this twenty first day of October one thousand eight hundred and fifty six
