 second part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Will-
 iam S. Mudd is the security of the said Samuel R.
 McClintock on a promissory note for sum of Eight
 dollars dated 9 day of January 1856. and due 25.
 day of December 1856. which note is made payable
 to Robert Hardin and by him transferred to Will-
 iam A. Walker who is now the holder and owner
 of the same and whereas the said Samuel R. McClintock
 is indebted to the said William S. Mudd in
 the sum of thirteen dollars on a promissory note
 dated January 24th 1856 & due one day after date &
 whereas the said Samuel R. McClintock is anxious to
 indemnify protect & save harmless the said Will-
 iam S. Mudd from any loss or injury on account
 of his said security and is also anxious to
 secure to the said William S. Mudd the pay-
 ment of the aforesaid note of thirteen dollars
 now therefore in consideration of the premises
 and the further sum of one dollar paid to

the said Samuel R. McClinton by the said Mrs. S. S. Sudd he the said Samuel R. McClinton has this day bargained sold and conveyed and doth hereby bargain sell & convey unto the said William Sudd the following described property to wit the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4 in Township 19 Range 3 West and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3 in Township 19 Range 3 West lands situate in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama also the growing crop of Cotton now cultivated by and the said Samuel R. McClinton on land rented from Octavian Spruill and one gray horse about six years old to have and to hold the same unto the said William Sudd his heirs and assigns upon the following terms & conditions first that if the said Samuel R. McClinton shall indemnify protect and save harmless the said William Sudd from all loss and injury on account of his said security ship and shall fully pay off and discharge the above and note of security Eight dollars on which the said William Sudd is security as above stated and shall also pay off and discharge the above and note of ten dollars on or before the first day of January next then this deed is to be void and of no effect.

Second that if the said Samuel R. McClinton shall not indemnify protect and save harmless the said William Sudd from all loss or injury on account of his said security ship or shall fail to pay & satisfy said note on which said William Sudd is the security as before stated or shall fail to pay & satisfy said note of thirteen dollars on or before the 1st day of January next in either of said events it shall be lawful for the said William Sudd on the said first day of January next or at any time thereafter when he shall desire so to do to take possession of said land house & crop in whatever condition the said crop may then be whether gathered or ungathered green or injured or packed or unpacked and to sell the same to the best bidder for cash before the Court house door in the Town of Elyton after having first given twenty days notice of the time and place of said sale by written notice posted up at the Court house door in Elyton and also on some public place in the County of Shelby and from the money arising from said sale to pay off and satisfy the note of security Eight dollars now held by William H. Walker on which the said William Sudd is security upon and also to pay of said note of thirteen dollars and the costs of this deed given under our hands and seals this 15th day of August 1857. S. R.
