 edged the said party of the first part has sold &

 Stark and an Arc Wagon and one fifth of
 of yellow or Clay bank Colored to have
 and hold in trust as follows it is hereby agreed
 that said party of the first part is to have and retain

possession of said property until the 15 day of November 1857 and if the said party of the first part shall fully pay to the said party of the 2^d part said debt with interest thereon and the reasonable Expenses there of by said 15 day of November 1857 then this Indenture is to be null and void but upon default of such payment the said party of the 2^d part is hereby authorized to take into possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for Cash after giving fifteen days notice of the time and place of said sale by advertisement posted up at three public places and out of the proceeds of said sale retain the said sum of sumity five dollars and interest thereon & the reasonable Costs hereof and the balance and the balance of any pay due to said party of the first part given under our hands and seals the day and year above written
