 Methodist Butler his wife by H R Lyman her atty in fact of Shelly
 Church County afforsed for and in Consideration of the sum of
 five dollars to us in hand paid by the Methodists
 Methodist Church of said County and State the sum
 whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted
 And Conveyed unto the said Methodist Church a
 certain parcel of ground to wit a certain portion of
 lot no thirty eight in the Town of Montevallo
 as follows Twenty two feet on Island Street & fifty
 feet on Middle Street to have and to hold the above
 granted & bargained parcel of ground to them the said
 Methodist Church at Montevallo to their own proper
 use and behoof forever and we the said Isaac
 Butler and James W. Butler by H R Lyman her atty
 in fact do for ourselves our heirs executors adveris
 tators and assigns Convey to and with the
 said Methodist Church at Montevallo that at
 and before the Execution of these Presents we
 are lawfully seized of the premises before named
 and that they are free of all encumbrance and that
 we have good right and lawful authority to
 sell and Convey the same in manner and form
 afforsed that the said Methodist Episcopal Church
 may occupy and enjoy the same without the evic
 tion or disturbance of us or any person claiming un
 der us In witness whereof we have hereunto
 set our hands and seals the 23 day of April
 1856.
