

Moore The State of Alabama, This deed made and in
 Do. Shelby County. Brought into this 21st day of
 September 1857 between Alexander Moore ad-
 ministrator of John Moore deceased of the
 Alexander first part and John Alexander of the second
 part. Witnesseth that whereas John Moore
 departed this life intestate being seized and
 possessed of the following land lying and being
 in said County and known as the North
 East quarter of Section Twenty Two²² the South
 East quarter of Section 15 and all that part
 of the East half of the South West quarter of
 Section 15 which lies East of Shoal Creek
 all in Township 22 Range three West and
 whereas Aaron Moore Administrator of said
 deceased petitioned the Probate Court of said
 County for leave power and authority to sell said
 land to enable him to make distribution and whereas
 said Court made a decree that said land be sold
 pursuant to said petition and whereas said adminis-
 trator proceeded to advertise and sell said land
 after due and legal notice and whereas John Alexan-
 der became the purchaser thereof at the price
 of ten dollars per acre to wit at the price of
 thirty five hundred dollars and whereas said ad-
 ministrator reported said sale to said Court and
 whereas said Court affirmed said sale and whereas
 said Alexander has made payment in full for
 said land and whereas said admin has applied to
 said Court for power and direction to make
 title to said Alexander for said land and whereas
 said Court has directed said administrator to make
 such title Now therefore for and in Consider-
 ation of the premises as well for and in Con-
 sideration of three thousand five hundred dollars
 to me in hand paid by said Alexander the receipt
 of which is hereby acknowledged I have given granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant
 bargain and sell to said John Alexander the land
 aforesaid being the tract of land before described
 and the land on which said John Moore lived
 at the time of his death as fully and completely
 in all things as I under the authority afore-
 said can do to have and to hold the same
 to the said John Alexander his heirs and
