This Indenture, made and entered into this fourteenth day of August, eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, between James C. Hand and Martha Hand, husband and wife, of the county of Shelby and State of Alabama, of the one part, and Jordan Jones, of the county and State aforesaid, of the other part, witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have this day bargained, granted, sold, aliened, enfeoffed and conveyed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, enfeoff and convey to the said Jordan Jones all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Shelby and State of Alabama and known and distinguished in plan of survey of said State as the South-East quarter of the South-West quarter, the South-West quarter of the South-West quarter, and the South half of the North-West quarter of the South-West quarter in Section thirteen, the South-East quarter of the South-East quarter, the South half of the North-East quarter of the South-East quarter, and the North-West quarter of the South-East quarter of Section fourteen; all in Township twenty-one Range two West, containing two hundred acres, more or less, in the District of land subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama: to have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land, together with all the tenements and appurtenances thereunto belonging or thereunto in any wise appertaining, unto the said Jordan Jones, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said James C. Hand and Martha Hand, husband and wife, for themselves and for their heirs, executors and administrators do warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said Jordan Jones, his heirs and assigns, from and against us and all and every person and persons claiming or holding by or from under the General Government of the
