

The State of Alabama Shelly County This Indenture
 Edmundson Made and entered into this 17 day of September A.D.
 Shiff 1857 between John Edmundson^a Sheriff of the County
 To of Shelly in the State of Alabama of the one part and
 Harrison And Gregory of the other part of the said
 & County of Shelly in the State of Alabama Witnesses
 Gregory that Whereas, on the 13 day of March 1857. Judgment
 was duly rendered in the Circuit Court for the County
 of Shelly in the State aforesaid at the Spring Term
 1857. of the said Circuit Court for the sum of Seventy
 Six 25/100 dollars, besides Costs in favor of Harrison
 And Gregory and against Charles Bragg on which
 said judgment there was issued by the Clerk of
 the Circuit Court for said County on the 1st day
 of April 1857. a certain Writ fieri facias in fa-
 vour of said Harrison & Gregory and against
 the said Charles Bragg directed to any Sheriff of the
 State of Alabama. Whereby said Sheriff was directed
 to levy of the Estate of said Charles Bragg the sum
 of Seventy Six 25/100 dollars, besides five dollars Costs
 And which said Writ was on the 9 day of April
 1857. placed in the hands of the said John Edmundson
 as Sheriff of said County of Shelly for the purpose of its
 levy and Execution. and Whereas said John Edmundson
 as Sheriff as aforesaid after the said Writ had come
 into his hands and while the same was in full force
 did on the 9 day of June 1857. levy the same on the
 following tracts of land as the property of said Defendant
 Charles Bragg viz the NW 1/4 & the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4
 and the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4
 of Sec 7 T 21 R 2 W and the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec
 12 T 21 R 3 W & the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec 7
 T 21 R 2 W also the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the same
 Sec Township and Range lying and being in the
 County of Shelly and Whereas the said John Edmundson
 as Sheriff as aforesaid after having duly advertised
 the said tracts of land for sale in the mode pre-
 scribed by Law. did in accordance with said adver-
 tisement on the 24 day of August 1857. in the town
 of Elbertonville proceed to sell the same under
 and by virtue of said Writ of fieri facias and
 the said Harrison and Gregory having bid for
 said land, then and there selling as afore-
 said the sum of one hundred and eighty four
 42/100 dollars it being the highest & best
 bid that could then and there be got for the same
 he the said Sheriff did therefore sell and cry off

This property was received from Harrison & Gregory within two years from date of the said sale - by requirement to them of all the purchase & interest & each as required by statute in such cases -

the said tract of land to the said Harrison & Gregory now therefore in consideration of the premises the said party of the first part as Sheriff of said County of Shelby has and does hereby bargain and sell unto And convey unto the said Harrison and Gregory the said tract of land to wit the NW¹/₄ & the SW¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ & the NE¹/₄ of the SW¹/₄ & NW¹/₄ of Sec 7 T 21 Range 2 West & NE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄ of Sec 12 T 21 R 3 W & the NW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ of Sec 7 T 21 R 2 W also the SW¹/₄ of the SW¹/₄ of the same section Township And Range to have and to hold the above said lands together with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Harrison and Gregory and to his heirs and assigns forever and the said party of the first part as Sheriff as aforesaid does Covenant with the said parties of the 2^d part that he as Sheriff as aforesaid will warrant the title to the said land so far as he by virtue of his said office is authorized to do but it is especially understood that said John Edmondson is in no event to be individually liable for any thing herein contained In testimony whereof the said party of the first part has signed sealed and delivered this deed on the day it bears date
