This agreement made and entered into this 26th day of October 1837 between Sally B Wood and Richard Wood husband & wife of the first part and Andrew B. Mosley of the second part Manupeth that for and in consideration of the love and affection which the Party of the first part hath for the said Andrew B. S. Mosley the said party of the first part have sold and hereby sells and conveys unto the said Andrew B. S. Mosley Eddy a negro woman slave aged about thirty two years and her child Sarah Elizabeth aged about four years to have and to hold forever with the following reservation only the said Sally B Wood is to have hold and enjoy the possession and labor of said negroes during her natural life at her death said negroes with all future increase to pass absolutely to the said Andrew B. S. Mosley Given under our hands and seals this the day and year above written
