do covenant with the said Quin and his heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises that they are free of all incumbrances that we have a good right to sell and convey the said land to the said Quin his heirs and assigns and we will warrant and defend the said premises to the said Quin his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons In witness whereof we the said Adams and wife have hereunto set our hands and seals this 19th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven.
