Renalds and Elizabeth Renalds husband and wife of the first part and Ananias M^cDoogle of the second part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and thirty five dollars to them in hand paid By the said Ananias M^cDoogle the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have sold and do hereby bargain sell and convey to the said Ananias M^cDoogle the following described land lying and being in the County of Shelby State of Alabama to wit South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section seventeen in Township twenty two of Range one West also the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section No Seventeen Township No Twenty two of Range No 1 West and the South West

quarter of the North West quarter West half of
 South West quarter and South East quarter of
 the South West quarter of section No seventeen
 in Township No twenty two of Range No one
 West to have and to hold to him his heirs and af-
 signs forever and the said party of the first part hus-
 band and wife do hereby covenant to and with the
 said Ananias McGoole that we are lawfully
 seized of said land and that they will forever
 warrant and defend the title to the above des-
 cribed lands to the said Ananias McGoole his
 heirs and assigns forever against the claim of
 all and every person whatsoever in law and
 equity and against the government of the Uni-
